- **Utilise Integrated Care principles** to drive innovation, improve outcomes, and reduce fragmentation across the Hawke's Bay health system.
- **Support service development** that is responsive, equitable, and sustainable through investment ensuring long-term impact and resilience.
- **Strengthening partnerships** across the network to enhance collaboration.
- Advocating for the value of the workforce, supporting and enabling those delivering care.

- Are committed to equity and whānau-centred care.
- Bring experience or interest in integrated care models.
